

English Language Arts 10-2 (5 Credits)

Course Description

The English 10-2 course is taught through four thematic units designed to meet the general and specific learning outcomes of Alberta Learning.

Units are designed to assist students in developing their reading, writing, speaking, listening, viewing and representing skills. In addition, students will demonstrate a sound comprehension of various forms of literature -such as poetry, short stories, a film and fictional novel -by reading and responding personally, critically and creatively.

Finally, students will be introduced to and will practice the three written components (Visual Response, Literary Exploration Essay and Persuasive Business Letter/Speech) of the current English 30 -2: Part A Diploma Exam.
