MAR 1 - Medicine River Wildlife Presentation

Through a powerpoint presentation The Medicine River Rehabilitation Centre will introduce the students to the concept of wildlife rehabilitation showing our hospital procedures and what people can do when finding injured wildlife. They give an overview of the species that they treat and the injuries they see. Next, a discussion on how humans impact wildlife and actually create the hazards, causing the injuries. They cross over into social issues and talk about how rumours and "bullying" harms both people and the environment. They attempt to leave students with the feeling that they have the power to make a difference.

The rehabilitation centre often brings one of their resident owls to presentations for students to see up close.
