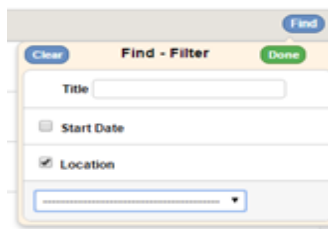

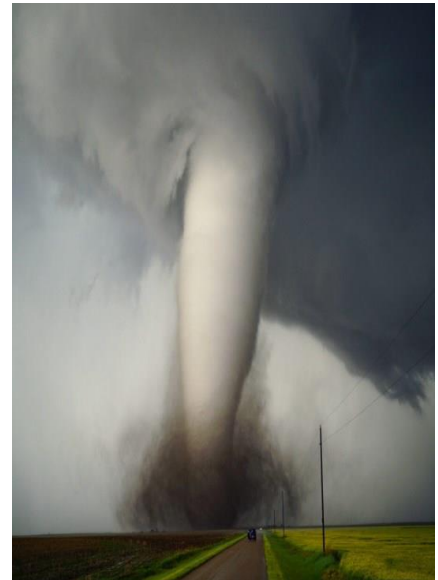

TORNADO HUNTERS

Learn about extreme weather phenomenon with TORNADO HUNTER Chris Chittack. Chris is one of the nation's experts on extreme weather.

The Tornado Hunter videographer Chris Chittick does not have a typical job. Chris works closely with emergency technicians, engineers and disaster relief organizations on education, prevention and survival in the field. Some say he is crazy, some say he's an extremist, and yet others say he's performing real science. Chris Chittick is by definition a storm chaser. Tornadoes, blizzards, hurricanes, water spouts; any phenomenon Mother Nature has the fortitude to create, he makes it his mission to conquer it. His weapon of choice is his camera – Chris Chittick has encountered more than 400 natural weather occurrences on two continents in his decade long career

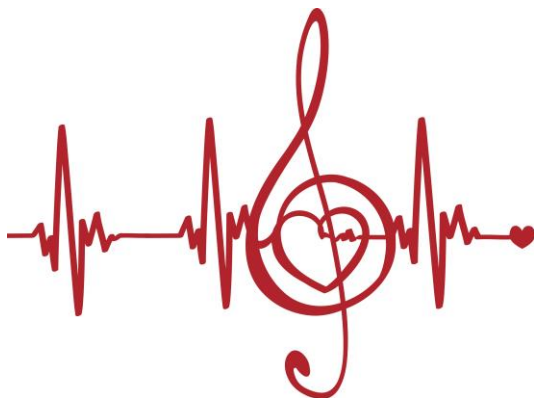
