

## **Math 10C (5 Credits)**

### ***Course Description***

Mathematics 10C –the ‘C’ stands for ‘combined’ – is the starting point for both the Mathematics -1 and Mathematics- 2 course sequences. These two possible routes are required for students who want to attend a university, college or technical institute after high school. Mathematics 10C includes topics such as algebra, number measurement, trigonometry, and relations and functions, with emphasis throughout on problem-solving to develop learners who question, investigate and explore solutions to problems.

As you can see from the diagram below, the content of the three course sequences (-1, -2, -3) differ so students gain necessary knowledge, skills and attitudes to be successful both in the workplace and in a variety of post-secondary programs.
